Digital Escape Room: Wild Safari Trek

FAQ Guide

- If you are having a hard time reading images please try using Zoom, hold the keys CTRL, SHIFT, and + together to increase size on screen.
- Puzzle 1
 - Did you open the link in a new tab? (if link is not working please contact us at mlockard@cc-pl.org)
 - Open the second provided help link if you cannot open the jigsaw link.
 - See end of FAQ for final jigsaw image as well.
 - Just use the number, do not spell it out.
 - Did you look at the image? Count how many animals are on Africa in the image.
- Puzzle 2
 - Using the images, subtract and add letters or words to create a new word.
 - All lower case letters.
- Puzzle 3
 - Are you using the suggested Color Code key?
 - Answer should be all upper case with no spaces.
 - What color is each animal placed in on the map?
- Puzzle 4
 - Do you see anything hidden on the dune?
 - Have you connected any dots? (Do not try to connect all dots to each other.)
 - How would what is hidden on the dunes connect to watching a video?
 - Is there a specific place on the video you should stop?
 - Just use the number, do not spell it out.
- Puzzle 5
 - Did you open the link in a new tab? (if link is not working please contact us at mlockard@cc-pl.org)
 - \circ $\;$ Pay attention to what animals are used in the matching game.
- Puzzle 6
 - There was code given in the winning message after you completed the matching game.
 - Make sure you read the winner message after completing the game.
 - o If you cannot open the game or you closed its tab too quickly, the error message
 - provides this hint: This is a famous hippo's birthday (MMDDYYYY).
 - All numbers, 8 digits, no spaces.
- Puzzle 7
 - Unscramble the words in the puzzle.
 - Take the letters of the unscrambled words that have a number underneath of them and plug them into the correct numbered box at the bottom of the puzzle.
 - Hint: What is the tallest mountain in Africa?

- Puzzle 8
 - Caesar Shift ciphers use the alphabet as a key, then you will take the number given and shift up/left on the alphabet from the letter in the scrambled message to find the correct letter.
 - There are cipher decoders on the internet if you would like to open a new tab and look for one using Google.
 - All lower case.
 - Match the deciphered route stops on the map to the correct route name.
- Puzzle 9
 - Do you see a number hidden on the provided image?
 - Hint: How high is this summit's elevation in meters?
- Puzzle 10
 - Follow the provided instructions.
 - Remember that each number from 1 to 16 is used only once. You can use the process of elimination.
 - Just use the number, do not spell it out.
- Puzzle 11
 - Use the maze image to find the correct hole where the meerkat will emerge.
 - Follow each route and write down when they change direction. Which one matches the information provided by the GPS tracking on the tablet.
- Puzzle 12
 - \circ ~ Use the number under each lock to input your answer in the correct order.
 - o Do these symbols represent some of the puzzles that you completed on your trek?
 - Think about your trek, in what order did you complete the puzzles and which puzzle does each symbol match up to?
