- If you are having a hard time reading images please try using Zoom, hold the keys CTRL, SHIFT, and + together to increase size on screen.
- Did you open the links in a new tab? (if link is not working please contact us at <u>mlockard@cc-pl.org</u>)
- Suggested devices for this game include tablets and computers as it is not optimized for mobile screens.
- Searching the Room
 - There are hidden links in each image, try clicking on different place in the room that you think a clue could be hidden to see a link appear.
- Puzzle 1
 - Another hint for this riddle: This is also faster than the speed of sound.
- Choice 1
 - Make a selection based on your previous answer. Wrong choices will lead back to this page.
- Puzzle 2
 - Extra Hint: Did you open the link in a new tab? (if link is not working please contact us at mlockard@cc-pl.org)
 - Answer should be all in UPPER case.
 - Another hint: Last name of a famous scientist.
- Puzzle 3
 - Use the provided table to decode the message.
 - Each section of numbers represents a letter, spaces have been placed between the sections to help you define separate letters in the word.
 - One word and answer should be in lower case.
- Choice 2
 - Make a selection based on your previous answer. Wrong choices will lead back to this page.
- Puzzle 4
 - Do you see anything that is different on some of the elements on the Periodic Table image?
 - Four elements have been indicated for you to use.
 - Answer is scrambled, you will need to unscramble it.
 - Answer should be in lower case.
 - Hint: This may be a name, but it also a breakfast food.
- Puzzle 5
 - Are you following the example for how the answer should be entered? Use the key to know how to answer: Upper case letter of Color with Shelf Number, no spaces in your answer

- You may need to open Google in a new tab to help identify the authors and the date these were published.
- Don't forget the hint from the previous puzzle of the author you are looking for.
- Puzzle 6
 - Are you following the example for how the answer should be entered? Upper case letter for the Color and its new Shelf Number
 - Hint: Remember the author name you were given earlier and which book you learned was written by him.
- Puzzle 7
 - Did you read the instructions for decoding a Book Cipher?
 - Use the numbers from the clue to count to a word in the passage, then use the first letter of that word to spell out a new word.
 - One word and answer should be all lower case.
- Choice 3
 - Make a selection based on your previous answer. Wrong choices will lead back to this page.
- Puzzle 8
 - Did you identify the correct group of elements? Try looking at what the different color groups mean on the Periodic Table image.
 - Are you following the example for how the answer should be entered? Just list the elements in a Alphabetic order with commas an spaces.
 - Six words and answer should be all lower case.
- Choice 4
 - Make a selection based on your previous answer. Wrong choices will lead back to this page.
- Puzzle 9
 - Look at the Periodic Table, what other information can you find for each element?
 - Where can you find an atomic number?
 - What order did you have the elements in for the previous puzzle?
 - 11 digits, no spaces.
- Puzzle 10
 - On the maze image, start at the green arrow and follow the phrase to the red star.
 - Keep track of the turns that you make.
 - Are you using the directional key? Answer should be UPPER case letters with no spaces.
 - o 13 letters.
- Puzzle 11
 - Answer the question. You may need to open Google in a new tab to help you find the answer.
 - Answer should be in all lower case.

- Hint: Has a famous artwork at a museum in Paris, France that is known for having a mysterious smile.
- Puzzle 12
 - Using the image, subtract and add letters or words to create a new word.
 - Try entering an answer, the error message for each word puzzle includes helpful hints!
- Puzzle 13
 - Look closely at the images of the pigments, do you see any information that would help you decide which colors to use?
 - Remember the clues and order from the previous puzzle.
 - Are you using the color code key? Answer should be UPPER case letters with no spaces.
