Register to Vote by Oct. 11

The Campbell County Public Library is making it easier for people to register to vote. People may stop by any of the Library's three branch locations to complete a Voter Registration Card. People wanting to vote in the 2016 Presidential election must be registered by Tuesday, Oct. 11. Election Day is Nov. 8.

The Library will accept completed voter registration cards until end of day on Monday, Oct. 10, and will deliver the cards to the Campbell County Clerk's office, 1098 Monmouth St. in Newport, the next day.

People also may register online at www.elect.ky.gov/. To find out individual polling-place locations or to confirm registration, people should call the Campbell County Clerk's office in Newport at 859-292-3885.

The Carrico/Fort Thomas and Cold Spring branches are voting locations and will be open from 6 a.m. – 6 p.m. for people to vote. All three branches will be open from 9 a.m. – 9 p.m. during regular business hours on Election Day.
